## **The Problem**


**Women & Children worldwide spend 200 million hours every day collecting water**

## **Simple Solutions**

- **\$1 can provide clean water for 1 person for 1 year**
- **A ceramic filter can provide clean water to a family of 5 for at least 5 years**
- **A biosand filter can provide clean water to a household for a generation or more**
- **New & repaired wells lift communities out of a cycle of waterborne illness**




